Notice to Exhibitors

This trial will be conducted under American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials. All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by contacting the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, by phone (919) 233-9767, by email at info@akc.org, or on their website at www.akc.org.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Puppies under 4 months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

The City of Springfield, MO has an ordinance pertaining to Pit Bulls. Any owner of a pit bull (American Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier) or any dog exhibiting these distinguishing characteristics will need to abide by this ordinance. When not showing your dog(s) you will need to have your dog(s) crated. When it is off show site it will have to be transported in a crate in your vehicle and muzzled when in public. Your dog(s) will NOT have to be muzzled when on our private show site.

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Katherine Emge at voyagergoldens@yahoo.com and the Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form or left blank by the owner or agent of the owner.

DAAO is accepting online entries through **LABTESTEDONLINE.COM**. Go to www.labtestedonline.com prior to opening date to register and for further information. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries – 175, Paper entries – 175, for a total of 350 runs per day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly. Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL.

Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid. In addition, entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Move-up must be made on or before Monday, May 29, 2023 at 6:00 PM CST.

Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees, or a returned check, or a postdated check do not constitute a valid entry. The club will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their future entries being put on a CASH ONLY basis. **Owners are responsible** for any errors on entry forms regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be returned in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. Duplicate entries will not be refunded if already processed. **A maximum of 10 entries** per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

DAAO is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing May 17, 2023 at 6:00 pm CST. A maximum of 40 entries per trial will be placed on the club's wait list. Any dogs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by dogs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a dog is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials.** Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date (May 29, 2023 at 6:00 PM CST) will be refunded in full.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. **Bitches in season** will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded all but \$5 per day of the entry fee. DAAO will also partially refund entry fees (minus an administration fee that will also include recording and judges fee) of any dog that has become injured or ill after the closing date of the trial and cannot compete. To receive all refunds, the trial secretary must receive written notification **prior to the start of the trial each day, and the exhibitor must provide a veterinarian certificate to the club within seven days of the trial.**

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

Dog Agility Association of the Ozarks may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against DAAO or any officials thereof.

If you would like to know the status in writing of your entry prior to the issuance of the running order upon closing, please enclose a self-stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry. **Confirmations and running orders will be emailed unless otherwise requested.**

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION AND RULE CHANGES

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. **FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.**

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. **FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.**
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

*****FEO (for exhibition only) is offered all days (Friday FAST, Saturday & Sunday T2B classes)**

Fix and Go

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run in any agility class.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Dogs that need to be measured must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Neither the club nor the Trial Secretary have any obligation or responsibility to provide a service through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Running Order Conflicts: The trial secretary will make every effort to minimize running order conflicts for a handler running two or more dogs in the same class and height, or in adjacent heights. On the day of a trial, if a handler feels more separation is needed, the club will make every effort to accommodate the request. When more separation is requested, per AKC rule, the judge must be asked to grant the change. The trial chair or gate steward may make the request on the handler's behalf. There are likely very few instances where the request will not be granted. Please note that, also per AKC rule, the second dog may be moved down in the order, but the first dog may not be moved up. Out of consideration for affected competitors, the scribe and the scorer, the club asks that all running order change requests be made no later than before the start of the briefing for the class in question.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Walk Throughs/ Ring /Warm Up/ Equipment Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

We will be splitting and doing walk throughs with the safety of our agility exhibitors, judge, and workers in mind. More information will follow in the confirmation as we finalize the plans for the trial.

Please do not touch any of the equipment during the walk throughs – thank you!

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

***** FAST will be a nested course for all levels and will be run as a combined class with all levels walking and running together, separated by jump heights.**

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. A copy of these regulations are available at <https://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf>

All classes will take place indoors (climate controlled) on soccer turf. Ring size is 85 feet X 110 feet (Standard Ring) and 80 x 110 (JWW Ring). **We will be using electronic timers, fully rubberized contacts** (including a Click and Go Teeter and dogwalk) **and a rubberized table.**

Measuring and Height Card Information

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete.

*****NEW!***** As of March 1, 2021, if a VMO or Agility Field Representative is measuring dogs at a trial, all present and entered dogs without a valid measurement must be measured.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Be Measured List.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible and neither are aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

After the close of entries, a dog, which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to the Novice "B" class. A request must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of EACH trial and must state the reason and justification for the move. A dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. (Chapter 1 Section 21)

After the close of entries, a dog, which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to the Novice "B" class. A request must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of EACH trial and must state the reason and justification for the move. A dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. (Chapter 1 Section 21)

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue

Qualifying Score	Dark Green

A MACH or PACH rosette and decorated MACH or PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain either a MACH or PACH title, and a custom embroidered director's chair will be awarded to any dog completing an AGCH at these trials. Please notify Sharon Chronister, trial chair at gchronister@msn.com if you think you may be completing a MACH, PACH or AGCH at our trials. A new title rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing a title at these trials. Dogs qualifying in both Master Standard and Master JWW at the same trial will receive a "Double-Q" award. Dogs Qualifying in Master FAST, Master JWW, and Master Standard will be awarded a "Triple-Q" ribbon. All dogs qualifying in the Premier classes will receive a special Premier qualifying ribbon.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Dog Agility Association of the Ozarks and its agents, employees etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Dog Agility Association of the Ozarks reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Dog Agility Association of the Ozarks, or any official thereof.

Dog Agility Association of the Ozarks will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. **The Dog Agility Association of the Ozarks**, Club officers and board members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

All dogs must be on leash at all times or otherwise confined when on trial/show grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course -- no exceptions.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

NO DOGS or EXHIBITORS are allowed on the outside soccer fields surrounding the arena. Please walk your dogs in the designated areas at the trial site. Remember to CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS – Thank you!

Please note that Lake Country Soccer Arena and surrounding grounds are a NON-SMOKING area.

SET UP AND CRATING INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

Setup will be available from 5 to 7 pm on Thursday, June 1, 2023

PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE ARENA OR SET UP PRIOR TO 5 PM on Thursday, June 1, 2023

The trial committee will remove any crates or setups that are found at the arena prior to our published set up time in these guidelines. If you would like to set up early as possible, please sign up to help unload on the online workers signup available in late May.

Crating space for exhibitors will be available at the main arena/ring area, in the west arena area, limited areas in the main hallway and upstairs. Please set your crates up in the designated marked areas ONLY. NO ex-pens and please stack your crates, especially if you have unentered dogs. **No one can set up in the arena until after the agility ring setup is completed and the crating space is marked.** Please bring mats or tarps to place under crates on the arena flooring/turf. Crates may be left overnight but DAAO and Lake Country Soccer will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Please bring your own water for yourself and your dog.

Please Note: There will be a FOOD TRUCK at this trial this year! You will be able to use your workers coupons for purchases. There are also various restaurants, fast food vendors, and grocery stores within driving distance.

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title. The request for a day-to-day move-up must be made to the Trial Secretary not later than 30 minutes past the last run the day preceding the event. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements.

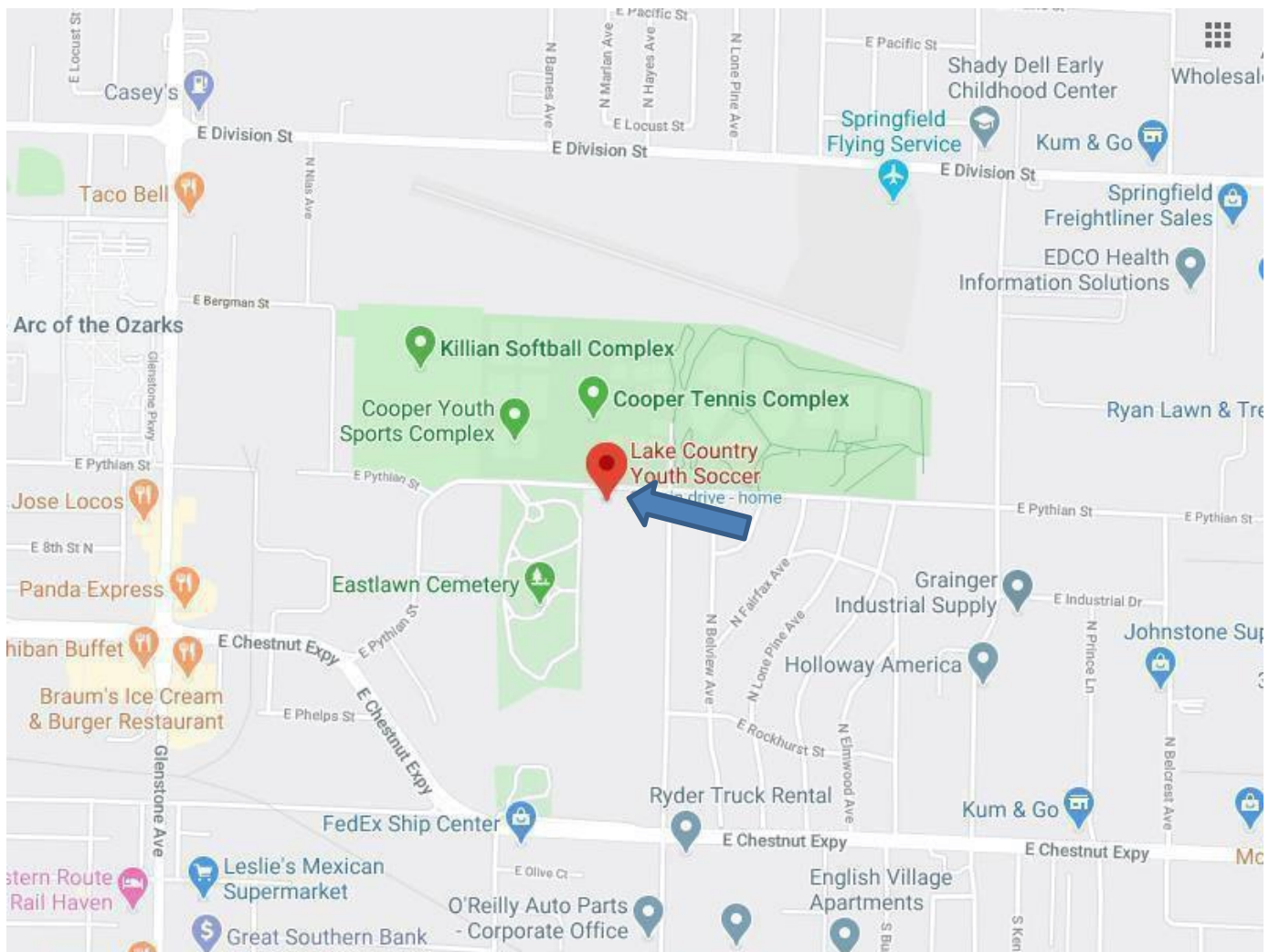

Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
